

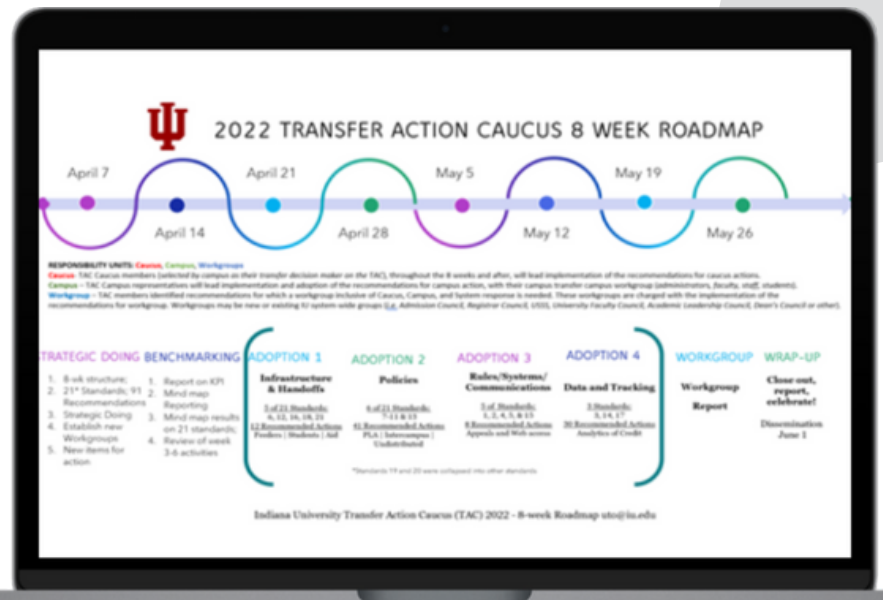

TRANSFER ACTION CAUCUS

MEMO:

Infrastructure and Handoff lead the charge on the following TAC items: Establish one transfer specific group; define a re-evaluation framework for credit evaluation policies; Re-organize location and access to web information on financial aid information.



WHAT HAPPENED?

During the Week 3 meeting focused on Infrastructure and Handoff three broad areas were covered: Rule policies for acceptance of credit, financial support, and student groups. Discussions centered on:

- 1) Need for a larger discussion on recommendations and acquiring capacity to assist in this process.
- 2) Campuses should re-evaluate policies around transfer credits by disciplines or department.
- 3) Consider showcasing availability of Financial Aid information and scholarships on web.
- 4) Seek ways to incentive student participation.
- 5) Work with other campuses to determine what is working or possible.

WHAT'S NEXT?

We will continue to assess the current state of barriers within the campuses and use strategic doing as a process to affect change on said items. Please continue to support this work as campus caucus leaders convene their home workgroups to deliberate, compile data, and make real-time changes during the 8 weeks.
