## **Indiana High School Rebranding of the STGEC**

Effective December 2020, the ICHE Student Success & Completion Committee has announced plans to rebrand and market the STGEC in <u>Indiana high schools to the "College Ready Core."</u> This rebranding was designed to increase general education core awareness and completion in Indiana high schools and advocate for quality dual credit courses among many other strategic goals. ICHE began a soft launch of the rebrand on December 10 which will be followed by a full launch with further steps to notify stakeholders in January 2021.

Indiana higher education institutions, including IU, will continue to refer to the general education core as the STGEC. At this time, no further action is needed by IU and no changes will be made to IU STGEC milestone processing.
