2021 NISTS Awards

New TSAP

The Secondary Education Chemistry TSAP was approved by ICHE in May 2020. UTO, in partnership with campus leadership, have begun to implement next steps to make the TSAP available Fall 2021. These steps have included acquiring 2-year TSAP plans, working with campus faculty to build curricula, and other campus processes.

Annual Campus Transfer Meetings

Each year, UAA hosts transfer discussions with each campus. General transfer trends via data generated transfer profiles, processing, policy, training, and other development updates are shared. These discussions ensure IU remains transfer friendly and is responsive to the needs of students and campuses. IU regional campus visits concluded on June 22. IUPUI and IUB are forthcoming. Executive summaries of the transfer data profiles and next steps are scheduled for a fall 2020 release. Partners in this work included UTO, USSS, Admissions and Institutional Research Officers, and campus leadership (EVCAAs, AVCAAs, and Department/School Dean's/Chairs) .
