Articulation Agreement Repository Update

As mentioned in the <u>July</u> and <u>August 2020</u> issue briefs, UTO has been working with each IU campus to collect internal and external articulation agreements by October 30. We are pleased to report we have collected all official agreements, excluding TSAPs or Guaranteed Admissions agreements, from each campus. In total, we gathered over 75 unique articulation agreements between seven partner institutions outside IU, with a majority being full associate bearing agreements. Individual agreements and information, organized by campus, can be found <u>here</u>. UTO also updated <u>articulation plans</u>, a map of curricular coursework, not agreements, to take at each institution to fulfill a degree objective.

With increases in articulation agreements, UTO has developed an official articulation agreement template. The aim is to provide guidance on what must be included. Additionally we hope for some semblance in uniformity, increase in archiving and updating said agreements in the future, and adding data mining features. - ACA-56: Transfer of Credit Completed at the 100 and 200 Level
- ACA-78: Transfer Credit Related to Military Service
- ACA-82: Transfer Credit from Associate's College Applied to an IU Baccalaureate Degree
