Spotlight

Transfer Student Advisory Board (TSAB): Creating a TSAB allows campuses to hear directly from transfer students. Read how IU Bloomington grew its TSAB and recruited students during events such as National Transfer Student week.

"In fall 2019, Bloomington's First Year Experience Programs (FYE) and the Office of Admissions recruited transfer students for the new Transfer Student Advisor Board (TSAB) during events such as an ice cream social and the National Transfer Student week. With 30 transfer students showing interest, we were able to elect an Executive Board, who started working in early spring. They attended Bloomington's NST Transfer Student Sub-Committee where they shared their transfer experience, provided ideas of where improvements could be made for future transfer students, and shared ideas of projects that they were planning. As of August 2020, the TSAB group has officially been added as a student organization on campus and has already welcomed new transfer students at a Welcome Station and at a Town Hall during IU Bloomington's Weeks of Welcome! We now have over 40 students who are part of the Bloomington TSAB going into the 2020/2021 school year."
