OPERATIONS



107,660

Transfer Courses
Processed

Between October 1 and December 31, UTO facilitated 107,660 courses transferred to IU. This is an average of 1,183 courses transferred every day, or the equivalent of 2,691 bachelor's degrees. Transfer courses serve to both shorten time-to-degree and increase student success.

Between October 1 and December 31, 4,381 students brought transfer credit to IU earned prior to enrollment. In addition, 1,729 students transferred credits earned after enrolling at IU. Of 46,776 credits posted, 10% were for courses taken after enrolling.

Credits Transferred
per student

3,618 transfer in Fall 2018 brought an average of **51 credits** to apply toward their baccalaureate degree. In addition, 58% of new freshmen brought an average of **18 credits** earned primarily through dual credit and AP or other test scores.

Created

Of the courses transferred this quarter, 6,463 resulted in the creation of a new rule. A new rule automates credit processing, continuing to increase efficiency for all students bringing credit into IU.

Institutions Entered

This quarter, we added 192 new institutions to IU databases. This allows for easier processing for frequent transfer institutions. In 2018, 1,938 transferring institutions were added.

The [Reverse Transfer Associate Degree](#) is a way for students who began at a 2-year college to complete their associate degree after transferring to IU. 454 students were identified in Fall 2018 as eligible to have their transcripts sent for degree analysis at 2-year colleges.
