UTO Website Google Analytics

The UTO office has been tracking the activity happening on our website so that we can better understand what information is being searched for. What we found is that 55% of our visitors go to the CTS page. That is over 900 visits a month.

The second most popular page was Steps to Transfer at about 10% with around 167 visits a month. How to Apply was the third most popular, coming in with around 150 visits per month.

We also tracked the most popular searched terms, which include: Transfer Credit, Credit Transfer Service, Transfer Students, Credit Transfer Requirements, Course Transfer IU, IU Credit Transfer, BSN, Hoosier Link, and ACP.
