2020 IU Transfer Symposium

CTL Currency Review Timeline for 2019-2020

The deadline to submit documents to CHE was October 4, 2019, and the deadline for uploading documents to Box for review was October 11. The CTL Currency Review began October 11, and the preliminary results will be submitted to CHE on January 10, 2020. The CTL Academic panel meetings will take place on March 27. The Approval Forms will be uploaded by March 30, and the CTL Final Approval Forms will be submitted to CHE on May 1. Finally, the CTL Database will be updated on <u>TransferIN.net</u> on June 5, 2020.

Forever GI Bill

The Harry W. Colmery Veterans Education Assistance Act, the "Forever GI Bill," is in the final stages of its implementation plan. Changes started taking effect August 17, 2017, the most recent change took place August 1, 2019, and the last change is due August 1, 2022.
